## Improving Subway Access – Proposed Bus Network Adjustments

### Toronto-York Spadina Subway Extension (TYSSE)

The TYSSE is an 8.6km rapid transit project that will extend the TTC's Line 1 subway from Downsview Station northwest through York University within the City of Toronto and north to the Vaughan Metropolitan Centre, in the Regional Municipality of York. There will be six new stations and the subway extension is scheduled to open in late-2017

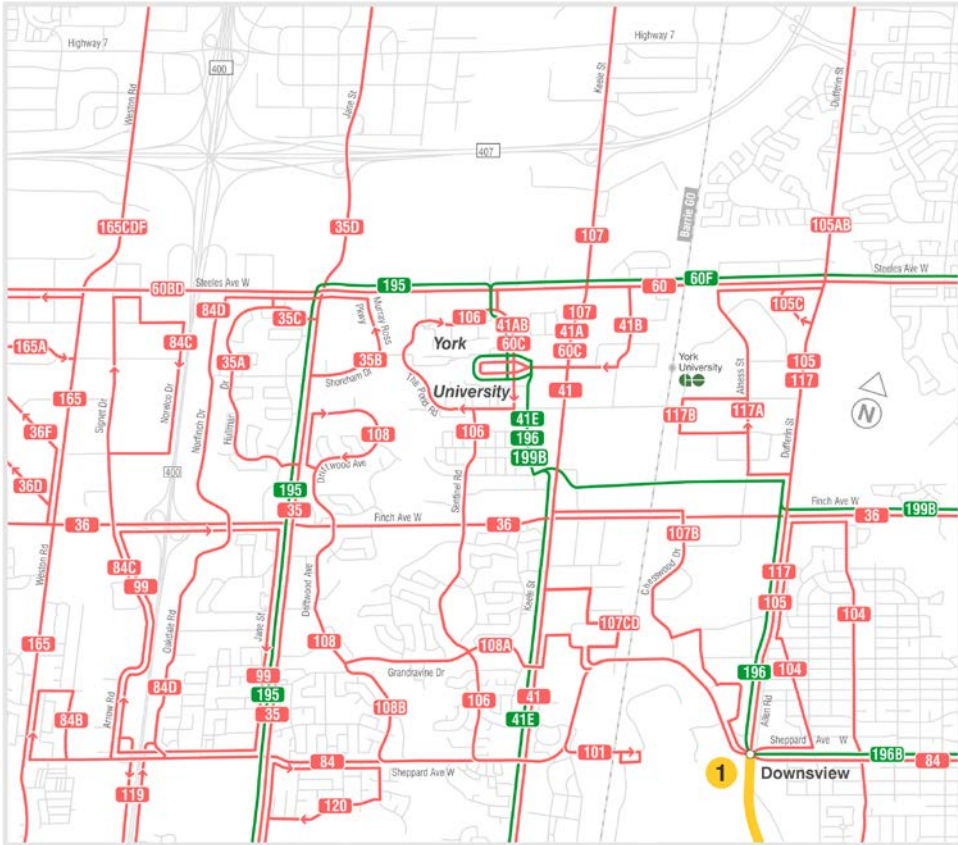
When the subway extension is open a number of bus routes will need to be re-routed in order to provide new connections to the subway.

The maps on the next page show the existing bus network and the proposed changes to the bus network to connect to the new subway extension. The proposed changes will provide new connections to subway service and improve overall travel time for customers. Key changes to the proposed network include:

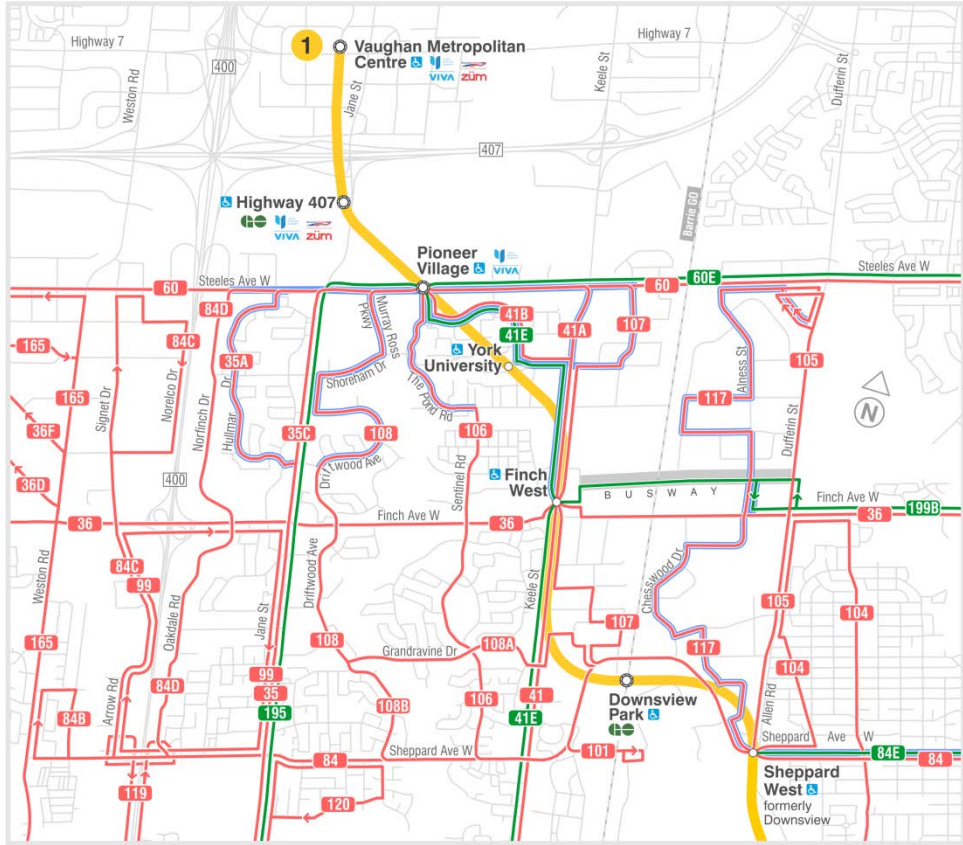
- Connecting bus services to serve new rapid transit stations where possible
- The 196 York University Rocket bus route will be replaced by the subway extension
- No buses will operate into York University Commons, but service will continue to operate around the York University campus
- York Region Transit buses will replace the service north of Steeles Avenue West on Weston Road, Jane Street, Keele Street and Dufferin Street

Starting November 14, a web page on the TTC website will be set up to share the proposed changes, and an online survey will be set up to collect feedback on some specific proposed route changes. TTC staff will also be going out to the community with display boards and pamphlets to promote and explain the proposed plans. The public engagement period on the draft plans will go from November 14 to December 5.
