Did You Apply for Your Credit Card Class Action Settlement?

Your business may be eligible to receive payment from a class action settlement related to inflated interchange fees.

If your business accepted VISA and Mastercard credit cards between March 23, 2001, and September 2, 2021, you may be eligible to receive some money from the class action settlement totalling \$131 CAD million. For more information on how to submit a claim or on the class action please visit

CaféTO Property Improvement Program Deadline: June 30, 2022

Eligible owners and tenants of commercial and industrial properties in Toronto can still apply for a fund created to support upgrading the appearance and/or function of exterior spaces. The first round of applications will remain open until June 30, 2022, or when funds are expended, whichever comes first.





Capacity Buyback Program to Encourage Reduction of Water Use

The Capacity Buyback Program offers eligible commercial and institutional organizations a free water audit and a one-time cash rebate. If you are interested to apply, please e-mail your letter of intent at savewater@toronto.ca or call 416-392-7000. If you meet the criteria, the City will arrange to have a professional engineer complete a thorough walkthrough and review of your organization's water use.





Check Your Eligibility for Sewer Surcharge Rebate from the City of Toronto

Under the Sewer Surcharge Rebate Program facilitated by the City of Toronto, businesses which divert more than 15% of their incoming water away from the sanitary sewer are eligible for a rebate on their water bill.
