

What We Can Learn from the Bank of Canada's Monetary Policy Report (April 2025)

While the Canadian economy ended 2024 on a positive note with inflation trending near the Bank of Canada's (BoC's) 2% target, and earlier interest rate cuts, which provided a stimulus to economic growth, this momentum has now been significantly challenged in 2025.

The unpredictability of the current global trade environment has made conventional economic forecasting unusually challenging, and the BoC has taken to outlining two illustrative scenarios instead of a single confident forecast for the Canadian economy. 


