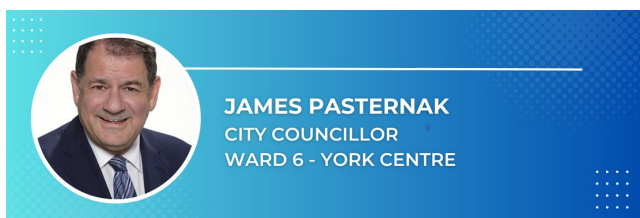
31 Division's Annual Toy and Food Drive

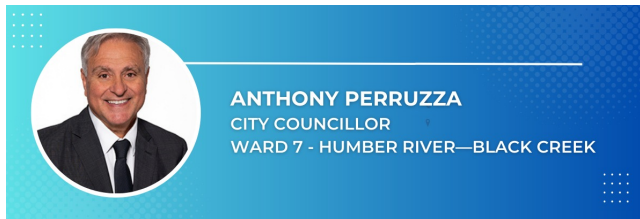
